1) The Beatitudes are a vision of the of a true disciple of Jesus.
• – poor in spirit <sup>3</sup> "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Matthew 5:3 (ESV)
• – mourning & meek  4 "Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.5 "Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth. Matthew 5:4-5 (ESV)
- hunger & thirst & merciful  6 "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied. 7 "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy. Matthew 5:6-7 (ESV)
• – pure heart & peacemaker  8 "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.  9 "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God. Matthew 5:8-9 (ESV)
