1) God is _____ for whatever comes my way.

⁹ Then was fulfilled what had been spoken by the prophet Jeremiah, saying, "And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the price of him on whom a price had been set by some of the sons of Israel, ¹⁰ and they gave them for the potter's field, as the Lord directed me." Matthew 27:9-10 (ESV)

- Jesus _____ Judas

¹³ And when day came, he called his disciples and chose from them twelve, whom he named apostles:...¹⁶ and Judas the son of James, and Judas Iscariot, who became a traitor. Luke 6:13,16 (ESV)

- Jesus _____ Judas would betray Him.

⁶⁴ But there are some of you who do not believe." (For Jesus **knew** from the beginning who those were who did not believe, and who it was who would betray him.) John 6:64 (ESV)

¹² While I was with them, I kept them in your name, which you have given me. I have guarded them, and not one of them has been lost except **the son of destruction**, that the Scripture might be fulfilled. John 17:12 (ESV)

⁹ But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation, into a snare, into many senseless and harmful desires that plunge people into ruin and **destruction**. 1 Timothy 6:9 (ESV)

- Satan _____ Judas.

³ Then Satan entered into Judas called Iscariot, who was of the number of the twelve. Luke 22:3 (ESV)

² During supper, when the devil had already put it into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him, John 13:2 (ESV)

- Jesus _____ Satan face to face.

²⁵ So that disciple, leaning back against Jesus, said to him, "Lord, who is it?" ²⁶ Jesus answered, "It is he to whom I will give this morsel of bread when I have dipped it." So when he had dipped the morsel, he gave it to Judas, the son of Simon Iscariot. ²⁷ Then after he had taken the morsel, Satan entered into him. Jesus said to him, "What you are going to do, do quickly." John 13:25-27 (ESV)

³ Then when Judas, his betrayer, saw that Jesus was condemned, he changed his mind and brought back the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and the elders, ⁴ saying, "I have sinned by betraying innocent blood." They said, "What is that to us? See to it yourself." ⁵ And throwing down the pieces of silver into the temple, he departed, and he went and hanged himself. Matthew 27:3-5 (ESV)

⁷⁴ Then he began to invoke a curse on himself and to swear, "I do not know the man." And immediately the rooster crowed.

⁷⁵ And Peter remembered the saying of Jesus, "Before the rooster crows, you will deny me three times." And he went out and wept bitterly. Matthew 26:74-75 (ESV)
