“³⁶“Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?” ³⁷And he said to him, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. ³⁸This is the great and first commandment. ³⁹And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. ⁴⁰On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets.”” (Matthew 22:36–40, ESV)

- **The spirit not the letter of the Law**

“⁵Not that we are sufficient in ourselves to claim anything as coming from us, but our sufficiency is from God, ⁶who has made us sufficient to be ministers of a new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit. For the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.” (2 Corinthians 3:5–6, ESV)

“⁹And he said to them, “You have a fine way of rejecting the commandment of God in order to establish your tradition!...But you say, ‘If a man tells his father or his mother, “Whatever you would have gained from me is Corban” ’ (that is, given to God)— ¹²then you no longer permit him to do anything for his father or mother, ¹³thus

making void the word of God by your tradition that you have handed down. And many such things you do.” (Mark 7:9–13, ESV)
