1) The New Covenant of Jesus was \_\_\_\_\_.

<sup>60</sup>yet I will remember my covenant with you in the days of your youth, and **I will establish for you an everlasting covenant.**” (Ezekiel 16:60, ESV)

<sup>31</sup>“Behold, **the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will make a new covenant** with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, <sup>32</sup>not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, declares the LORD. (Jeremiah 31:31–32, ESV)

<sup>1</sup>Now the point in what we are saying is this: **we have such a high priest**, one who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in heaven, <sup>2</sup>**a minister in the holy places**, in the true tent that the Lord set up, not man.” (Hebrews 8:1–2, ESV)

<sup>24</sup>For **Christ has entered**, not into holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true things, but **into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God on our behalf.... he has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.** <sup>27</sup>And just as it is appointed for **man to die once, and after that comes judgment,**... (Hebrews 9:24–28, ESV)
