1) Jesus is Lord & in _____.

*“⁷And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write: ‘The words of **the holy one, the true one**, who has **the key of David**, who **opens and no one will shut, who shuts and no one opens.**’ (Revelation 3:7, ESV)*

“⁸‘I know your works. Behold, I have set before you an open door, which no one is able to shut. I know that you have but little power, and yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name.’ (Revelation 3:8, ESV)

Your servant will go and fight with this Philistine.’ ³³And Saul said to David, ‘You are not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him, for you are but a youth, and he has been a man of war from his youth.’” (1 Samuel 17:32–33, ESV)

“⁹But he said to me, ‘My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.’ Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. ¹⁰For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong.” (2 Corinthians 12:9–10, ESV)

3) In the end everyone will _____ Jesus is Lord.

“⁹Behold, I will make those of the synagogue of Satan who say that they are Jews and are not, but lie—behold, I will make them come and bow down before your feet, and they will learn that I have loved you.” (Revelation 3:9, ESV)

“⁹Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.” (Philippians 2:9–11, ESV)

4) Hold on to what God has _____ given you.

“¹⁰Because you have kept my word about patient endurance, I will keep you from the hour of trial that is coming on the whole world, to try those who dwell on the earth. ¹¹I am coming soon. Hold fast what you have, so that no one may seize your crown.” (Revelation 3:10–11, ESV)

5) In heaven I’ll _____ my closeness to God.

“¹²The one who conquers, I will make him a pillar in the temple of my God. Never shall he go out of it, and I will write on him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down from my God out of heaven, and my own new name.” (Revelation 3:12, ESV)

“¹³He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.” (Revelation 3:13, ESV)



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
