"...4For if someone comes and proclaims another Jesus than the one we proclaimed, or if you receive a different spirit from the one you received, or if you accept a different gospel from the one you accepted, you put up with it readily enough." (2 Corinthians 11:3–4, ESV)

"2preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching." (2 Timothy 4:2, ESV)

"8But when Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord." ... (Luke 5:8–11, ESV)

"19Do not quench the Spirit. ²⁰Do not despise prophecies, ²¹but **test everything; hold fast what is good**." (1 Thessalonians 5:19–21, ESV)

2) The First Gospel Event

"Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand... ³For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, ⁴that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, ⁵and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve." (1 Corinthians 15:1–5, ESV)

"3Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? 4We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death...(Romans 6:3–4a, ESV)

o Paul taught this.

"12Now if Christ is proclaimed as raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?" (1 Corinthians 15:12, ESV) [2 Cor. 5:20-21; Gal. 1:4]

o Peter taught this.

"23this Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified... (Acts 2:23, ESV)] Acts 4:27-28]

"30The God of our fathers raised Jesus, whom you killed by hanging him on a tree." (Acts 5:30, ESV) [Acts10:39, 13:28-29]

"22"And if a man has committed a crime punishable by death and he is put to death, and you hang him on a tree...." (Deuteronomy 21:22–23, ESV)
