1) Jesus is Lord is the _____ affirmation of the New Testament.

...if you confess with your mouth that **Jesus is Lord** and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved....¹¹For the Scripture says, "Everyone who believes in him will not be put to shame." ¹²For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the **same Lord is Lord of all**, bestowing his riches on all who call on him. ¹³For "everyone who calls on the **name of the Lord will be saved.**" (Romans 10:8–13, ESV)

⁹For to this end Christ died and lived again, that he might be Lord both of the dead and of the living." (Romans 14:9, ESV)
